### **MEDICINE**

STEP inTO OxMed is a medic's outreach group aiming to increase the proportion of students from under-represented groups at Oxford University Medical School. We deliver a host of programmes to help equip sixth form students with the skills and confidence to put forward a competitive medicine application.

This is the sign up form for our Clinical Skills Workshop, an in-person event at the John Radcliffe Hospital where sixth form students are invited to learn practical clinical skills from current students, including phlebotomy, suturing and CPR. Students will be taught the basics of history taking, and challenged in groups to assess and manage simulated patient scenarios. This is also an excellent opportunity to speak to our Oxford Medical students about the medicine admissions process and interviews!

The session dates available are either the 15th or 16th February 2025. The day runs from 10am-4pm at the John Radcliffe Hospital, Headley Way, Headington, OX3 9DU.


