

What As one of the most established programmes of its kind in the UK, UNIQ offers participants access to step-by-step online support as well as a residential based in an Oxford college. The programme is completely free and gives pupils the chance to meet Oxford <u>academics</u>, <u>speak to current students and learn first-hand about the application process and</u> what life might be like at Oxford.

### Astrophoria Foundation Year Oxford

What The University of Oxford's Astrophoria Foundation Year is a one-year fully-funded programme with additional full bursary to cover accommodation and living expenses. The course enables motivated students to reach their academic potential through a supportive and challenging academic course aimed at developing their skills, self-belief and academic confidence. Students passing the course are awarded a nationally recognised Certificate in Higher Education (CertHE) qualification. If passed at the required level, they will be automatically admitted to their chosen undergraduate degree course, without the need to re-apply. Students are also supported to apply to other universities using their CertHE qualification if not continuing onto the full degree programme at Oxford.

Who For UK state school students predicted to meet A level entry requirements ranging from BBB-AAB (depending on course selected) with significant academic potential, who have experienced severe personal disadvantage and/or disrupted education which has resulted in them being unable to apply directly for an Oxford undergraduate degree programme.

When Full time study will begin in October 2025.
